Risk assessment and selection of appropriate equipment is paramount in order to prevent the formation of pressure ulcers, heal existing ulcers and improve patient outcomes. The second part of this course highlights mattresses as a medical device and outlines best practice in mattress cleaning, care, transportation and auditing. A collaborative approach can lead to significant reductions in mattress failure rates and an increased return on investment of pressure reducing equipment.
